Pope Leo's First General Audience

"I am happy to be with you in this the first General Audience of my Pontificate. Today we have taken up the series of catechesis on the Jubilee theme of "Christ, our Hope," begun by Pope Francis reflecting on Jesus' parable of the Sower and the Seed. What can strike us is the generosity, even recklessness, with which the sower casts the seed on all kinds of soil, even the rocky terrain that seems most unpromising. Jesus explains that the seed is God's Word, which is meant to take root in the hearts of all, none excluded. We who hear this parable and apply it to our own lives, may well feel challenged to become a better and more receptive terrain for the working of His grace."
