Sacrifice and gift

Many people have memories of the **C**orpus **C**hrist procession when the monstrance with the Blessed **S**acrament was brought around the parish. All groups in the parish were represented. Children scattered petals before the host and houses were decorated. The meaning of the feast was to bring the **L**ord into the streets of his people and to appreciate the gift he gives us of himself in the **E**ucharist. This procession still takes part in many places.

On Holy Thursday we also celebrate the **E**ucharist, but in another way. It is more of the sacrifice of **J**esus on **C**alvary.

We unite ourselves with his offering that brought him to death, and look forward to the resurrection when the risen **L**ord would be present in many ways among people, including in the form and shape of bread and wine.

On the feast of the **B**ody and **B**lood of **C**hrist, the emphasis is more on gift than on sacrifice.

The Eucharist as Gift

This is what he wishes to leave us as a gift forever. It is the way he could give himself forever in a very close way, so that this is his gift of '*food for the journey.*'

We need this gift. We need to know certainly that **G**od is close with us in life, and the **E**ucharist at Mass gives us this certainty. We need to know that **G**od is really present in our lives, and we know this in the real presence of the **E**ucharist.

Tully Church Ecclesiastical Site Jubilee Prayer Service

On Sunday 22nd June 2025 at 3:00 pm, Fr. Paul will conduct a Jubilee Prayer Service at Tully Church. Local Parishes are invited to attend and we will also be joined by Rev. John Tanner and a number of the Tullow Church parishioners. This initiative is being organised in response to Pope Francis's announcement last year of 2025 as the Jubilee Holy Year with the theme "**Pilgrims of Hope**". To get to Tully Church for this Jubilee Prayer Service, you are invited to either join a 1.30 pm guided walk with local historian and tour guide, **Liz Pilkington** or to drive and to meet the group at Tully Church at 3pm. If joining for the walk (leaving Brennanstown Standing Stones in Holmwood at 1.30 pm), please RSVP to the Parish office. To ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment, please note that places are limited and the guided walk is available on a first come, first serve basis. If you prefer, you can also join via car or Luas. For those driving, there is parking in Tully Park beside the playground or alongside the Cherrywood Educate Together National School. Once parked, the 5-minute walk to Tully Church is well signposted.

On Sunday June 22nd, Feast of Corpus Christi the parish of **Sallynoggin will have a Corpus Christi Procession**. the Procession will leave the Church directly **after the 11am Mass**. The route will last approximately 25 minutes and All are Welcome
